

AMTIL Event Code of Conduct

AMTIL are committed to providing events that are welcoming, respectful and safe for all participants, both in person and on digital platforms.

We expect all participants including visitors, exhibitors, sponsors, speakers, contractors, suppliers and all staff to uphold the principles of this Code of Conduct at all AMTIL events, including Australian Manufacturing Week and any related activities. Unacceptable behaviour includes, but is not limited to:

- Behaviour that is deemed as offensive, disruptive, disrespectful, or degrading to others, including verbally or written, images, or interactions by anyone, in any form, regardless of location.
- Harassment or discrimination based on race, sex, age, gender, gender identity and expression, sexual orientation, national origin, religion, disability and marital status, or any other characteristic protected by Australian Federal and state laws and regulations.
- Sexual harassment via inappropriate physical contact and unwelcome attention whether verbal, physical or otherwise.
- Threats, intimidating or violent behaviour, whether verbal, physical or written, including obscene language or intimidating gestures.
- Inappropriate dress attire that is deemed as improper or offensive, including but not limited to images, symbols or slogans.

We encourage all participants to report any concerns, unacceptable behaviour, unsafe or disruptive activity to the event team, the nearest venue staff or security.

Anyone asked to stop unacceptable behaviour is expected to comply immediately. If a participant does not comply, AMTIL, the venue staff and security may take appropriate and necessary action, including but not limited to, removal from the event, rejection from participating in future events, and reporting any unlawful behaviour to the appropriate authorities.

All determinations of acceptable and unacceptable behaviour are at the sole discretion of AMTIL, and its event team and the decision(s) will be final.

This Code of Conduct may be revised at any time and is non-negotiable. It is designed to ensure that AMTIL events can be enjoyed by all participants.

AMTIL reserves the right to refuse admittance to or remove any person from an AMTIL event at any time at its sole discretion.
